

Getting Started Guide

Bluetooth Headset - Open Ear

1. Microphones

Dual noise-canceling microphones exclude surrounding noise, effectively enhancing your speech when using a two-way radio

2. Multifunction Button

Do not use

- AWC recommends using the two-way radio's push to talk button instead of the multifunction button

3. LED Indicator

- Solid Red: Charging
- Solid Blue: Charging Complete
- Flashes Red and Blue: Pairing Mode
- Flashes red every 2 minutes: Low Battery

4. Micro-USB Charging Port

Connect the charging cable to the micro-USB charging port. The LED will light red while charging.

5. Volume Up/Power Button

- Volume Up: Click while receiving a transmission to increase volume
- Power On/Off: Press and Hold for 2 seconds
- Battery Status: Click while not sending or receiving (Battery High, medium, low (or) charge me)
- Pairing: Begin with the headset off. Press and hold for 5 seconds, the headset will speak "pairing" and the LED will flash blue and red while in discovery. When paired, the headset will speak "connected"

6. Volume Down

- Volume Down: Click while receiving a transmission to decrease volume
- Battery Status: Click while not sending or receiving (Battery High, medium, low (or) charge me)
