Quick Start Guide

Bed/Chair Sensor Pad with Transmitter

Using a Sensor Pad can help alert facility staff when a resident is at increased risk for a fall due to self transfer attempts or other high-risk behavior.



Turn OffBegin with the transmitter switch in the off position.



Place the Sensor Pad
With attached transmitter on
the bed or chair.
For this example the bed sensor pad is

being used.



Place Resident on Pad Once the resident is settled, turn the transmitter to the on position.



If the Resident Gets Up
The staff will be notified via
two-way radios, the Dashboard,
and scrolling signs.
If applicable.



Turn OffThe transmitter before repositioning the resident on the pad.



Place Resident on Pad Then turn the transmitter to the on position.

Please Note

Placing the Resident On the Pad Will Not Reset the Alarm

The transmitter must be turned to the off position to reset the alarm.
